

CONTRACT FOR TRIAL-RUN # EJB-23-01

PLACE: LOS ANGELES, DATE:

_____, represented by _____ hereinafter referred to as the "**Customer**", on one hand, and ECOJETBOX COMPANY represented by Nurzhan Toishy, hereinafter referred to as the "**Provider**", on the other hand, both hereinafter referred to as the "**Parties**", have concluded this Agreement on the following:

1. Legal terms and definitions.

- 1.1 **Product.** The product herein is ECOJETBOX IMPULSE GENERATOR. The product can be one of two models: 1-truck model 24V, 2-CAR/SUV model 12V. Technical description and packing information of the models are shown in Annex 1 of this contract which is an integral part of the present contract.
- 1.2 **Models herein are:**
- 1.2.1 ECOJETBOX IMPULSE GENERATOR truck model 24V,
 - 1.2.2 ECOJETBOX IMPULSE GENERATOR CAR/SUV model 12V.
- 1.3 **Trial-run** is the testing effort by the customer on the product, according to the test instructions, described in Annex 2 of the present contract, which is an integral part of this contract.
- 1.4 **Period of trial-run** is ____ calendar days after the date of receiving the product by the customer.
- 1.5 **Fuel:** herein are gas, gasoline, and diesel.
- 1.6 **Vehicle:** herein is an automobile that is moved by only an internal combustion engine, which in its turn uses gas, gasoline, or diesel as fuel and that has a 12V or 24V electric system.
- 1.7 **Effect of the product** herein is the effect of the use of the product, which is:
- 1.7.1 Reduction of fuel consumption of vehicles.
- 1.8 **Aim of the contract:** To help the customer find out if his vehicle or vehicles consumes or consume less fuel with the product connected to his vehicle or vehicles in comparison with not using the product connected to his vehicle or vehicles. Achieving the aim lets the customer make his decision to further buy the product or not under the separate sales contract.
- 1.9 **Deposit (chose only one out of two):**
- 1.9.1 **Option 1:** herein is the full price of the product with the sales tax of California. The full price of the product with sales tax (9.5% for zip 90012) of California, Los Angeles, is set forth in Annex 3 of the present contract, which is an integral part of this contract.
 - 1.9.2 **Option 2: no payment.**
- 1.10 **Testing efforts** herein are the efforts described in Annex 2 of the present contract, which is an integral part of this contract.
- 1.11 **ECOJETBOX COMPANY** is Mr. Nurzhan Toishy herein.

2. Subject of the contract.

- 2.1 The provider gives to the customer the product (under Option 1, article 1.9 herein) against the deposit set forth in Annex 3 of the present contract by the customer or (under Option 2, article 1.9 herein) free of charge for trial-run in models and quantity set forth in Annex 3 of the present contract, which is an integral part of this contract, and the customer makes the testing efforts described and set forth in Annex 2 of the present contract for the period of trial-run to achieve the aim of the contract.
- 2.2 The model, quantity, and the full price of the product with sales tax of California, Los Angeles 9.5% given by the provider to the customer for trial-run under the present contract are set forth in Annex 3 of the present contract, which is an integral part of this contract.
- 2.3 The amount of deposit of this contract that the customer gives to the provider for the period of trial-run under the Option 1, article 1.9 herein (if chosen) is: _____, and the amount is also set forth in Annex 3 of the present contract.

- 2.4 After the customer accomplishes the trial-run under the present contract the customer returns the product given by the provider for a trial-run to the provider's address set forth in article 10 herein.
- 2.5 The cost of the transportation of the product for trial-run from the provider to the customer and from the customer to the provider under the present contract is covered by the provider. The transportation is done with the help of USPS mail service or by other means accepted and approved by the provider only.
- 2.6 The provider bears no responsibility for all related expenses to trial-run performed by the customer such as fuel cost, depreciation, traffic fees, penalties, or whatsoever except expenses to ship the product to the customer for trial-run and returning the product back to the provider hereunder.

3. Contract amount and settlement procedure.

- 3.1 The present contract has no amount except the amount of the deposit temporarily given by the customer to the provider for the period of trial-run. The deposit is supposed to be returned to the customer against the return of the product to the provider after the period of trial-run.

4. Rights and obligations of the parties.

- 4.1 The customer follows the product instructions, and safety requirements set forth in Annex 4 of the present contract, which is an integral part of this contract.
- 4.2 The customer follows the testing effort instructions set forth in Annex 2 of the present contract, which is an integral part of this contract.
- 4.3 The customer consents to the clauses of the warranty and disclaimer information on the product set forth in Annex 5 of the present contract, which is an integral part of this contract.
- 4.4 In the case of Option 1, article 1.9 herein The customer deposits the amount of _____ to the account of the provider for the period of trial-run to the account of the Provider set forth in article 9 herein.
- 4.5 The provider ships the customer the product for trial-run in models and quantity set forth in Annex 3 of the present contract, which is an integral part of this contract, within two business days after the date of receiving the deposit mentioned in article 4.4 if the Option1, article 1.9 herein is chosen and otherwise after the agreement date.
- 4.6 The provider refunds the deposit set forth in article 4.4 herein within two business days after the date of receiving the returned product in models and quantity provided under the present contract on conditions of product return described in Annex 5 of the present contract, which is an integral part of this contract.
- 4.7 In case of any damage caused to the product or its package or loss of any item in the product package in case of Option 1, article 1.9 herein the deposit remains with the provider and becomes an asset of the provider and the provider reports this amount as a sale and pays taxes on it as required by the law of the USA, while the product remains with the customer as his property with the warranty and disclaimer set forth in Annex 4 of the present contract. In case of the failure to return the product by the customer the exchange of the deposit against the product under the present contract for trial-run is considered as a purchase of the product by the customer from the provider under the clauses of warranty and disclaimer set forth in Annex 4 and the customer is to follow all instructions and information set forth in Annex 4 herein. In this case, all Annexes of the present contract are in power. Parties may in this case conclude a separate sales contract and transfer the interaction under this contract to a separate sales contract that will terminate the present contract. The template of the sales contract is shown in Annex 5 of the present contract. In this case, the clauses of the sales contract set forth in Annex 5 of the present contract come into force. In the case of Option 2, article 1.9 herein the customer compensates the price of the lost product as per the official price list of Ecojetbox indicated on the website: www.ecojetbox.com
- 4.8 If the customer fails to return the product to the provider after the period of the trial-run the deposit remains with the provider and becomes an asset of the provider and the provider reports this amount as a sale and pays taxes on it as required by the law of the USA, while the product remains with the

customer as his property with the warranty and disclaimer set forth in Annex 4 of the present contract. In case of the failure to return the product by the customer the exchange of deposit against the product under the present contract for trial-run is considered as a purchase of the product by the customer from the provider under the clauses of warranty and disclaimer set forth in Annex 4 and the customer is to follow all instructions and information set forth in Annex 4 herein. In this case, all Annexes of the present contract are in power. Parties may in this case conclude a separate sales contract and transfer the interaction under the present contract to the sales contract that will terminate the present contract. The template of the sales contract is shown in Annex 5 of the present contract.

4.9 The customer informs the provider in written form on the following:

4.9.1 Information about the vehicle of the customer: make, model, year of manufacture, vin code, battery/electric system voltage. That information will be shown in Annex 6 of the present contract, which is an integral part of the present contract. This information is needed to make sure the provided model for trial-run is compatible with the customer's vehicle.

4.10 The serial number of the product given for the trial-run under the present contract is shown in Annex 3 of the present contract.

5. Liability of the Parties.

5.1 The liability of the provider is set forth in Annex 4 of the present contract and article 4 “**Rights and obligations of the parties**” of the present contract.

5.2 In case of failure of the customer to return the product under the present contract and the product becomes a subject of sale as it is set forth in Provision 4.7 herein the clauses of the sales contract set forth in Annex 5 come into force. In this case, the parties will sign a separate sales contract shown in Annex 5 of the present contract.

6. Force Majeure.

6.1 Neither party shall be liable to the other Party for non-fulfillment of obligations under this Agreement due to the action of force majeure circumstances, i.e. extraordinary and unavoidable circumstances under these conditions, including: declared or actual war, civil unrest, epidemics, blockade, embargo, fires, earthquakes, floods, and other natural disasters.

6.2 A certificate issued by the relevant competent authority is sufficient evidence of the existence and duration of force majeure.

6.3 A Party that does not fulfill its obligations under this Agreement due to force majeure shall immediately notify the other Party of such circumstances and their impact on the performance of obligations under the Agreement.

6.4 If force majeure circumstances are valid for 3 (three) consecutive months, this Agreement may be terminated by either Party by sending written notice to the other Party.

6. Dispute and Resolution Procedure.

6.1. Disputes and disagreements that may arise during the execution of this Agreement will, if possible, be resolved through negotiations between the Parties.

6.2. If it is impossible to resolve disputes through negotiations, they shall be considered by the arbitration court in accordance with the procedure established by the legislation of California and the USA at the court situated in Los Angeles, CA, USA.

7. Procedure for amendment and termination of the contract.

7.1. Any changes and additions to this Agreement are valid only if they are in writing and signed by both Parties.

7.2 This contract is considered terminated when the customer returns the product for trial-run to the provider and the provider accepts it, and when the customer gets the deposit returned under the present contract.

7.3 This contract is considered terminated when the parties decide to conclude a separate sales contract for the product earlier given for trial-run under the present contract without returning the product to the provider and returning the deposit to the customer. In this case, the deposit becomes the payment for the product including taxes and the product is considered a purchase.

8. Miscellaneous.

8.1 This contract shall enter into force on the date of signing the present contract.

8.2 In case of a change of the location, name, bank details, etc. of any of the Parties, the parties are obliged to notify about that the other Party in written form within 10 (ten) days, and the letter must indicate that it is an integral part of this contract.

8.3 This contract is drawn up in two copies, having the same legal force, one copy for each of the Parties.

9. Other conditions at the discretion of the Parties.

8.5 Issues not regulated by this Agreement shall be resolved in accordance with the law of the USA and California.

ANNEX 2 OF THE CONTRACT

TEST INSTRUCTIONS

REQUIREMENTS AND STEPS (INSTRUCTIONS) FOR THE TEST EFFORTS:

Requirement on the Condition of the vehicle.

All the parts of his vehicle must be in normal working condition as designed by the manufacturer. In case some parts of the vehicle are not in normal working condition as designed by the manufacturer then the user should not connect ECOJETBOX impulse generator to his vehicle.

Requirements on speed, distance, weight, fuel, fuel price, and road for testing:

Speed:

- 1) During the test efforts the customer should keep possibly one and the same average speed of the vehicle.

Distance:

- 2) The distance to go during the test is 50 (with ECOJETBOX impulse generator)+50 (without ECOJETBOX impulse generator)=total of 100 miles minimum (recommended 100+100=200 miles).

Weight:

- 3) During the test the weight of the vehicle should be the same from the beginning to the end of the test. For example, if the vehicle goes with a connected ECOJETBOX impulse generator in full load for the first half of the test then the vehicle goes unloaded the rest half of the testing without ECOJETBOX impulse generator the results will be irrelevant.

Road:

- 4) The sort of road must be the same during the test (if you chose a certain road for the first half of the testing please use the same road for the second half of the testing). For example, if the vehicle goes 50 miles uphill for the first half of the test and then goes 50 miles downhill without ECOJETBOX impulse generator during the last half of the test, the results will be irrelevant.

Fuel:

- 5) Use only one and the same type of fuel during the test otherwise the result of the test will be irrelevant. Fuel may be a certain sort of gas, gasoline, or diesel.

Fuel price:

- 6) It is important to buy fuel at the same price per gallon so to make accurate calculations for reasonable decision.

The time needed for the test:

The provider gives 7 calendar days to test ECOJETBOX impulse generator from the date of receiving ECOJETBOX impulse generator.

STEPS OF THE TEST (INSTRUCTIONS FOR TESTING):

A. Driving without ECOJETBOX impulse generator:

- 1) Go to a gas station to fill your fuel tank up to 100% of the tank volume.
- 2) Write down the total run mileage indicated on the odometer panel of your vehicle. (m1)
- 3) Make sure you didn't connect ECOJETBOX to your vehicle (you are going to drive your vehicle at least 50 miles for the test WITHOUT ECOJETBOX impulse generator).
- 4) Drive 50 miles at least.
- 5) After driving 50 miles stop and go to the nearest gas station to fill your fuel tank up to 100% of its volume.
- 6) Write down the volume of fuel bought (f1 in gallons) and its amount in USD (p1 in USD).
- 7) Write down the mileage indicated on the odometer panel of your vehicle (m2).

B. Driving with ECOJETBOX impulse generator:

- 8) Make sure you connected ECOJETBOX impulse generator to your vehicle according to the instruction and safety requirements. (You are going to drive your vehicle at least 50 miles for the test WITH ECOJETBOX).
- 9) Drive 50 miles at least or exactly the same mileage as you did in item 4) of this test instruction.
- 10) After driving 50 miles stop and go to a gas station to fill your you tank up to 100% of the tank volume.
- 11) Write down the volume of fuel bought (f2 in gallons) and its amount in USD (p2 in USD).
- 12) Write down the mileage indicated on the odometer panel of your vehicle (m3).
- 13) Make the following calculations:

1. Calculate the miles run without ECOJETBOX impulse generator:

$$x1=m2-m1;$$

2. Calculate the miles run with ECOJETBOX impulse generator:

$$x2=m2-m3;$$

3. The fuel consumed to run without ECOJETBOX impulse generator (x1 mileage): f1;

4. The fuel consumed to run with ECOJETBOX impulse generator (x2 mileage): f2;

5. The money spent to run without ECOJETBOX impulse generator (x1 mileage): p1;

6. The money to run with ECOJETBOX impulse generator (x2 mileage): p2;

7. Calculate miles per gallon without ECOJETBOX impulse generator: $mpg1=x1/f1$;

8. Calculate miles per gallon with ECOJETBOX impulse generator: $mpg2=x2/f2$;

9. Ideally now $mpg2$ should be more than $mpg1$ ($mpg1 > mpg2$);

10. Calculate the percentage of mpg increase $z1(\%)$: $z1=((mpg1/mpg2)/mpg1)*100=?\%$;

11. Calculate the oil cost saving $z2(\%)$: Provided that $m1=m2$ and $p1 > p2$: $z2=((p1-p2)/p1)*100=?\%$;

12. Please note that prices per gallon on gas station must be the same to determine $p1$ and $p2$;

If you see that there is mpg increase ($z1 > 0\%$) and reduction of fuel consumption ($z2 > 0\%$) then it is a proof to make positive decision to buy ECOJETBOX impulse generator.

ANNEX 4 OF THE CONTRACT

Warranty/disclaimer for ECOJETBOX impulse generator Truck model 24V, and car/SUV model 12 V

Seller: ECOJETBOX COMPANY, www.ecojetbox.com

Product: ECOJETBOX impulse generator.

Models covered: 1) Truck model 24V, 2) car/SUV model 12 V

Warranty period for ECOJETBOX impulse generator: 1 year from the date of purchase.

Warranty period for interior connection wire, and fuse box connection wire: 7 calendar days from the date of receiving.

WARRANTY LIMITATIONS THAT MAY IMPACT CONSUMERS

To the extent permitted by law, this warranty and the remedies set forth are exclusive and supersede any and all other warranties, remedies, and conditions, whether oral, written, statutory, express or implied.

ECOJETBOX COMPANY disclaims any and all statutory and implied warranties, including and without limitation, warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose and warranties against hidden or latent defects, to the extent permitted by law. In so far as such warranties cannot be disclaimed, ECOJETBOX COMPANY limits the duration and remedies of such warranties to the duration of this warranty only. Goods are to be sold "as is"

WARRANTY COVERAGE

1. This Warranty covers that ECOJETBOX COMPANY replaces the purchased ECOJETBOX impulse generator that has factory defects with another new ECOJETBOX impulse generator within the warranty period (for COJETBOX impulse generator the warranty period is 1 year after the purchase date, and for connection wires, the warranty period is 7 days after receiving date). The warranty is given against ECOJETBOX impulse generator, interior connection wire, and fuse box connection wire that have damages or defects caused by the manufacturer. The replacement ECOJETBOX impulse generator, interior connection wire, and fuse box connection wire will be sent to the user by USPS mail service at ECOJETBOX COMPANY's expense in the boundaries of the territory of the USA using USPS company. This clause covers three items in a package: ECOJETBOX impulse generator, interior connection wire, and fuse box connection wire.
2. In case the user discovers the purchased ECOJETBOX impulse generator is not working during the course of the Warranty period, the user is to send it to ECOJETBOX COMPANY at his own expense using USPS company. If ECOJETBOX impulse generator is not working due to the fault of the manufacturer then the cost of return will be indemnified by ECOJETBOX COMPANY against the proof of payment to USPS related to the return.
3. If within 7 calendar days from the date of receiving the purchased interior connection wire, and fuse box connection wire that is included as an accessory to ECOJETBOX impulse generator is not working, the user is to send it to ECOJETBOX COMPANY on his own expense using USPS

company. If the connection wires are not working due to the fault of ECOJETBOX COMPANY then the cost of return will be compensated by ECOJETBOX COMPANY against the proof of payment to USPS related to the return.

4. The warranty is valid only if it was not damaged by improper use of the ECOJETBOX impulse generator by the user.
5. The warranty period may be extended by ECOJETBOX COMPANY in cases described on the website: www.ecojetbox.com See, the EXTENDED WARRANTY chapter there.
6. ECOJETBOX COMPANY warrants the ECOJETBOX -branded hardware product and accessories contained in the original packaging ("ECOJETBOX IMPULSE GENERATOR") against defects in materials and workmanship when used normally in accordance with ECOJETBOX COMPANY's published instructions for warranty period. ECOJETBOX COMPANY's published instructions include but are not limited to information contained in technical specifications, user manuals, and service communications.
7. ECOJETBOX COMPANY will refund 100% of the purchased ECOJETBOX impulse generator if the user returns it within 30 calendar days with all its items, packages, and papers as it was at the moment of purchase together with the proof of payment. In case of refunding the returned ECOJETBOX impulse generator, ECOJETBOX COMPANY doesn't cover the user's expenses related to sending to the address of ECOJETBOX COMPANY shown on the website: www.ecojetbox.com

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

1. No ECOJETBOX COMPANY reseller, agent, or employee is authorized to make any modification, extension, or addition to this warranty. If any term is held to be illegal or unenforceable, the legality or enforceability of the remaining terms shall not be affected or impaired. This warranty is governed by and construed under the laws of the country in which the ECOJETBOX COMPANY Product purchase took place. ECOJETBOX COMPANY is identified at the end of this document according to the country or region in which the ECOJETBOX COMPANY Product purchase took place. ECOJETBOX COMPANY or its successor in title is the warrantor under this warranty except as provided in this warranty and to the maximum extent permitted by law, ECOJETBOX COMPANY is not responsible for direct, special, incidental or consequential damages resulting from any breach of warranty or condition, or under any other legal theory, including but not limited to loss of use; loss of revenue; loss of actual or anticipated profits (including loss of profits on contracts); loss of the use of money; loss of anticipated savings; loss of business; loss of opportunity; loss of goodwill; loss of reputation; loss of, damage to, compromise or corruption of data; or any indirect or consequential loss or damage howsoever caused including the replacement of equipment and property, any costs of recovering, programming, or reproducing any program or data stored in or used with the ECOJETBOX COMPANY product or any failure to maintain the confidentiality of information stored in the ECOJETBOX COMPANY product. The foregoing limitation shall apply to death or personal injury claims, or any statutory liability for intentional and gross negligent acts and/or omissions.
2. ECOJETBOX COMPANY disclaims any representation that it will repair any ECOJETBOX COMPANY product under this warranty or replace the ECOJETBOX COMPANY product without risk to or loss of information stored on the ECOJETBOX COMPANY product. Some states (countries and provinces) do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitation or exclusion may not apply to you.
3. The terms of the warranty cannot be used as terms of an insurance policy.
4. ECOJETBOX COMPANY does not bear any liability and or responsibility for any damages to a vehicle claimed and not claimed caused by using ECOJETBOX impulse generator and its connection wires. ECOJETBOX impulse generator and its connection wires are designed and

manufactured in a manner that can not cause any damage to a vehicle it may be used on.

5. Warranty does not cover the following cases:

1. ECOJETBOX COMPANY reveals defects resulting from mechanical damage due to non-compliance with the rules of transportation, handling, or use.
2. Damage is caused by a road accident, fire, flood, other natural disasters, or other conditions falling under the concept of force majeure.
3. ECOJETBOX impulse generator was installed and connected to the fuse box of the user's vehicle not by ECOJETBOX COMPANY staff or by specialists unauthorized by ECOJETBOX COMPANY.
4. ECOJETBOX impulse generator was opened by the user or by specialists unauthorized by ECOJETBOX COMPANY with the purpose of repair or any alteration.
5. ECOJETBOX impulse generator is missing any or both of the two connection wires. (interior connection wire and fuse box connection wire).
6. Damage to the purchased ECOJETBOX impulse generator was caused by improper handling, as well as violation of the installation, and safety instructions.
7. Damage to the purchased ECOJETBOX impulse generator was caused by external impact, temperature, chemical influence, road or any other accident, careless handling, ingress of aggressive liquids, any physical damage, dirt, and whatsoever.
8. Damage was caused by the high or low temperature of any nature or putting it in any type of liquid substance.
9. ECOJETBOX impulse generator truck model 24V was connected to a vehicle with a 12V electric battery and if ECOJETBOX impulse generator car/SUV model 12V was connected to a vehicle with a 24V electric system.
10. ECOJETBOX impulse generator was connected to any equipment or machines that are not considered vehicles.
11. ECOJETBOX impulse generator was connected to electric vehicles or vehicles with a non-internal combustion engine, motorcycles, flying vessels like planes and jets, along with vessels like ships, yachts, and whatsoever.
12. ECOJETBOX impulse generator was stored or kept or used by a user in direct sunlight, high temperatures, or sunk in any liquid, near explosive, radioactive substances and whatsoever.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Take ECOJETBOX impulse generator out of the box.
2. Take the Interior connection wire (cigarette lighter socket) out of its plastic bag.
3. Connect the interior connection wire to ECOJETBOX impulse generator.

3.6 The buyer timely pays the total of the delivered goods according to Annex 1 herein.

4. OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES AND LIABILITIES.

4.1. For non-fulfillment or improper fulfillment of obligations under this Contract, the Parties are liable under the current legislation of the United States of America, California, and this Contract.



REQUIREMENTS AND STEPS (INSTRUCTIONS) FOR THE TEST EFFORTS:

Requirement on the Condition of the vehicle.

All the parts of his vehicle must be in normal working condition as designed by the manufacturer. In case some parts of the vehicle are not in normal working condition as designed by the manufacturer then the user should not connect ECOJETBOX impulse generator to his vehicle.

12. To remove ECOJETBOX impulse generator or disconnect it:
 1. Turn off the vehicle. Remove the key. Make sure your car is completely switched off.
 2. Carefully remove the connector of the Interior connection wire from the cigarette lighter socket.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Keep ECOJETBOX impulse generator away from high temperatures or fire.
2. Do not put in water or any other type of liquid.
3. Do not drop or throw ECOJETBOX.
4. Do not keep at low, high temperature or under the sun or near radioactive substances and chemically active substances.
5. Keep away from children.
6. Do not connect to anything except vehicles working on gas, gasoline, and diesel fuel that have only 12V (for car/SUV MODEL 12V) and only 24V(for truck model 24V) in their electric system.
7. Any vehicle working on gas, gasoline, or diesel has protection fuses of 5A minimum. ECOJETBOX impulse generator uses the connection wires where there is an installed fuse of 2-3A. That means that the protection system of our product will react to any short circuit in your vehicle's electric system that equals or exceeds 2 or 3A. Our fuse will protect your car earlier in this case while the fuses of your vehicle will react only if the short circuit equals or exceeds 5A.
8. Note, that in the case of connecting the impulse generator to your vehicle's fuse box using a fuse box connection wire, the polarity of the vehicle electrical system and polarity of the impulse generator must be strictly taken into consideration. Negative polarity “-” wire should be connected to the vehicle's body while Positive “+” wire should be connected to the “+” polarity of a fuse in the vehicle's fuse box. A wrong connection with the wrong polarity will create a short circuit and may kill ECOJETBOX impulse generator.
9. Connecting ECOJETBOX impulse generator to your vehicle's fuse box using the fuse box connection wire and placing ECOJETBOX impulse generator under the bonnet must be done only by ECOJETBOX staff or specialists authorized by ECOJETBOX company. ECOJETBOX COMPANY disclaims any and all statutory and implied warranties, including and without limitation, warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose and warranties against hidden or latent defects, to the extent permitted by law. In so far as such warranties cannot be disclaimed, ECOJETBOX COMPANY limits the duration and remedies of such warranties to the duration of this warranty only. Goods are to be sold "as is"

WARRANTY COVERAGE

1. This Warranty covers that ECOJETBOX COMPANY replaces the purchased ECOJETBOX impulse generator that has factory defects with another new ECOJETBOX impulse generator within the warranty period (for COJETBOX impulse generator the warranty period is 1 year after the purchase date, and for connection wires, the warranty period is 7 days after receiving date). The warranty is given against ECOJETBOX impulse generator, interior connection wire, and fuse box connection wire that have damages or defects caused by the manufacturer. The replacement ECOJETBOX impulse generator, interior connection wire, and fuse box connection wire will be sent to the user by USPS mail service at ECOJETBOX COMPANY's expense in the boundaries of the territory of the USA using USPS company. This clause covers three items in a package: ECOJETBOX impulse generator, interior connection wire, and fuse box connection wire.
2. In case the user discovers the purchased ECOJETBOX impulse generator is not working during the course of the Warranty period, the user is to send it to ECOJETBOX COMPANY at his own expense using USPS company. 3.
